<u>FORMATS</u>: Three Game Guarantee + possible playoff game / 50 Minute Games /Applications are invited from competitive Boys and Girls club, select and academy teams. Passes from all national governing bodies accepted. All players must have a current, valid player pass. Guest players allowed (5 maximum)

<u>TO ENTER</u>: Complete the online application entry form accessed from GotSoccer and from the Stateline SC Tournament webpage (*StatelineSC.com*). To complete online application, payment must accompany application. Acceptances will not be processed until payment is received. (For those unfamiliar with processing eChecks, there is basically no difference between mailing a check in or entering items of information off the face of that same check into the online application payment page).

<u>DEADLINES</u>: Applications requested by June 1, 2018. Qualified teams will be accepted on a rolling basis.
